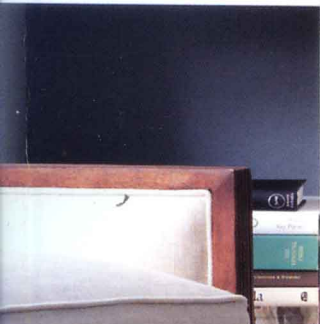
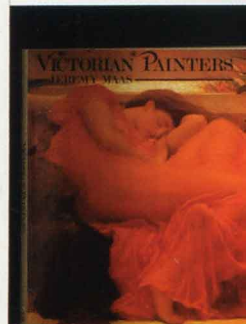

**I. A GRAND ENTRANCE** Lee Caswell and Blaise Gaetz preserved the historic character of their 163-year-old home in Port Hope, Ont., while adding modern-day convenience under the front hall staircase. When converting the basement to a separate apartment, they removed a staircase leading to the lower level, which made way for a powder room, heating and storage. Two slide-out shelves and a cupboard hold everything from shoes to tools to recycling bins.
